



The first thing to be said regarding Chapman and Cull's new book, *Projecting Tomorrow* is that it is pleasure to read; in an appealing, clear and witty style, Chapman and Cull analyze twelve key science fiction films in order to trace the evolution of the genre from David Butler's *Just Imagine* (1930) all the way to James Cameron's *Avatar* (2009).

The result is both entertaining and highly instructive, as Chapman and Cull shed light not only upon the conditions of production of each film, i. e., their respective historical and cinematic contexts, but present as well their socio-cultural implications and semiotic contents, smoothly shifting from contextual to textual description and interpretation. While the introduction justifies the corpus of study underlining the merits of the selected films, the afterword introduces the new cultural trends that inform the study of science fiction cinema at large, observing in particular an increasing independence of the medium vis-à-vis its traditional sources of inspiration, such as novels, plays, novellas and short stories, suggesting hence that cinema is more than ever in the process of articulating itself as a complete culturally and artistically significant narrative vehicle.

Projecting Tomorrow is an important work for several reasons; first, it represents a direct and fundamental contribution to the on-going elaboration of a popular cultural canon, for it allows us to perceive the merits of traditionally frowned upon cultural narrative products, such as science fiction films, and their influence not only on our society but also on the manner in which we understand our reality. Secondly, from a theoretical point of view, Chapman and Cull's book is nothing short than exemplary: as cultural studies are plagued by over-conceptualized jargon and often exhibit a definite disdain towards primary sources, which more often than not serve as mere pretexts to promote pre-existing ideological agendas, *Projecting Tomorrow*, on the contrary, is firmly grounded upon empirical data and leaves no room for idle, theoretically esoteric speculations.

This is not to say that Chapman and Cull are not theoretically informed, far from it, but rather that their approach privileges the primary sources and remains within the scope of their study, which makes *Projecting Tomorrow* much more informative and convincing than many current postmodern, stylistically challenged essays on popular culture.

Chapman and Cull are not only teaching us about how we projected tomorrow through twelve key science fiction films: they are themselves projecting what the future of cinema and cultural studies ought to be.



La búsqueda de la coexistencia en el paisaje patrimonial es abordada a través de la construcción de modelos arquitectónicos para la integración de infraestructuras viarias en el territorio, en conjuntos singulares como Mont Saint Michel y Stonehenge, el lago de Zurich y el Camino de Santiago, o los viaductos de Garabit y de Millau.

The release of 'Things to Come' in 1936 was one of the key moments in the history of science fiction in the cinema. The film was the brainchild of H. G. Wells, whose worldwide reputation as a thinker had persuaded its producer, Alexander Korda, to offer him a contract giving him virtually total control over the project. Korda drafted a dazzling array of talents to render into pictures Wells's ideas of the future a hundred years hence. His brother, Vincent Korda, a distinguished painter, was employed as art director, and the Bauhaus artist Laszlo Moholy-Nagy contributed ideas for futuristic sets.

As director, Korda hired William Cameron Menzies, who had practically invented the profession of Hollywood art director through his work with Douglas Fairbanks on 'The Thief of Baghdad' and Rudolf Valentino on 'Son of the Sheik,' and whose career would climax with 'Gone With the Wind.' The result was a landmark in cinematic design. Christopher Frayling shows, with a wealth of illustrations, how the boldness and brilliance of the sets and costumes mark out 'Things to Come' as British cinema's greatest contribution to the science fiction genre, amply justifying his judgement that "Things to Come 'is to modernism as 'Blade Runner' is to postmodernism."

Reseña

Fritz Lang's classic 1927 film *Metropolis* has justifiably become an icon for the complexities of Weimar culture. Among the important general issues it also raises are the relation between ideology and art, the status and authorship of the film text in the entertainment market, the city, the construction of gender, the relation between the human body and the machine in modernity, and the relation between mass and high culture.

This volume provides a broad range of materials and resources for the study of Lang's film, including both well-known, previously published critical essays and contributions appearing for the first time here.

The editors provide a two-part introduction that furnishes context for what follows: Bachmann's part deals with the genesis, production, and contemporary reception of the film, while Minden's defines the problems posed by the text and reviews the solutions to these problems as proposed by later generations of critics. The first part of the book proper includes selected contemporary reviews, commentary by Fritz Lang and others involved in the making of the film, and extracts from Thea von Harbou's original novel. In the second part, eight modern scholars provide fresh essays on the genesis, promotion, and reception of the film.

Approximately half of the material in the volume has never before appeared in print. The volume will appeal to students of German, film, cultural and intellectual history, and social theory. Michael Minden is University Lecturer in German at Cambridge University and a fellow of Jesus College. Holger Bachmann received his Ph.D. from Cambridge on Arthur Schnitzler and film.



Reseñas

This is the first collection to be inspired and informed by the new films and archival material that glasnost and perestroika have revealed, and the new methodological approaches that are developing in tandem. Film critics and historians from Britain, America, France and the USSR attempt the vital task of scrutinising Soviet film, and re-examining the Cold War assumptions of traditional historiography.

Whereas most books on Soviet giants have glorified the directorial giants of the 'golden age' of the 1920s, Inside the Film Factory also recognises the achievements of popular cinema from the pre-Revolutionary period through to the 1930s and beyond. It also evaluates the impact of Western cinema on the early experimenters of montage, Russian science fiction's influence on film-making, and the long-suppressed history of Soviet Yiddish productions. Alongside the new perspectives and source material on the much-mythologised figures of Kuleshov and Medvedkin, the book provides the first extended accounts in English of the important but neglected careers of directors Yakov Protazanov and Boris Barnet.

En el aluvión de conmemoraciones de los eventos, quizá no deberíamos olvidar la aparición de la más importante publicación contracultural, el Whole Earth Catalog, que vio la luz por vez primera en el otoño de ese *annus mirabilis*. Promovido por el escritor, fotógrafo, militar y titulado en Biología por Stanford Stewart Brand, el Catalog procuraba dar acceso a multitud de productos y servicios reconciliando el utopismo tecnológico con la conciencia ecológica, y llevando el espíritu de la contracultura a un terreno distinto al de la moda, la música, las drogas o el sexo. Objeto de sucesivas ediciones, vendió casi dos millones de ejemplares entre 1968 y 1972, y se convirtió en una herramienta informativa imprescindible y en un objeto de culto. Surgido en el contexto de la cultura Beat, el movimiento de los derechos civiles y de la liberación de la mujer, el activismo contra la Guerra de Vietnam y frente al deterioro del medio ambiente, el Catalog tuvo como referencia tutelar a Buckminster Fuller, cuyas ideas e inventos se glosaban en las primeras páginas del volumen, y cuyas cúpulas geodésicas se convertirían en el emblema arquitectónico de esa generación.

La experiencia del Catalog se ha estudiado en la última década por muchos investigadores, que se han beneficiado del depósito de los papeles de Brand en la Universidad de Stanford. Fred Turner publicó en 2006 el libro definitivo sobre el Whole Earth Network como precursor del utopismo digital y de internet, mostrando hasta qué punto existió una fertilización cruzada entre el 'Flower Power' de San Francisco y el hub tecnológico de Silicon Valley; Andrew G. Kirk se ocupó en 2007 de la relación entre el Catalog y la contracultura verde, explorando su influencia en el diseño ecológico y en el movimiento de la tecnología alternativa; y Simon Sadler, que publicó libros relevantes sobre la ciudad situacionista y sobre Archigram, ha estudiado en detalle la dimensión arquitectónica del Catalog, que dio lugar con Lloyd Kahn a publicaciones independientes como Shelter y los diferentes Domebooks.

Pero para los que no llegaron a conocer los catálogos originales, quizá el libro más útil es el que ha publicado Caroline Maniaque-Benton, una selección de 80 textos extraídos de The Last Whole Earth Catalog, la edición definitiva de 1971, y que transmite maravillosamente el espíritu de aquella aventura intelectual y editorial. Desde Fuller o Victor Papanek hasta Ian McHarg, Lawrence Halprin, Frei Otto o Nicholas Negroponte, todos los grandes temas del Catalog se evocan a través de artículos míticos, precedidos de una extensa introducción de la autora sobre su historia editorial. En la exposición de Fuller celebrada en Ivorypress en 2010, la última sección mostraba dos decenas de libros de gran formato inspirados por el visionario inventor estadounidense, incluyendo varias ediciones del Catalog, genuino motor de aquel momento mágico de la contracultura californiana, que se alumbró hace medio siglo pero cuya onda expansiva llega aún fresca hasta nosotros.

Resumen

Son innumerables las exposiciones, conferencias, reuniones, cursos y otras actividades que, con el apoyo del Colegio, han organizado nuestros compañeros arquitectos para fomentar y divulgar la cultura arquitectónica. Las 'Sesiones de fotografías comentadas' que fueron el origen de esta publicación son un ejemplo de una de estas iniciativas.

La idea de organizar dichas sesiones nos la propuso Ricardo Sánchez Lampreave cuando vino a Burgos a presentar la exposición sobre el libro *La Ilusión de la Luz*, que había editado junto a Iñaki Bergera. Ante su propuesta, un grupo de compañeros hicimos nuestro el proyecto y decidimos poner en marcha una iniciativa similar que reuniera fotografías y relatos a través de los cuales pudiéramos compartir nuestra forma personal de ver, entender y vivir la arquitectura. Durante tres años, siempre contando con la presencia de Ricardo entre nosotros, acudimos a estos encuentros en la sede del Colegio.

Fueron tres citas domésticas por su carácter tan familiar y entrañable, como solo puede darse cuando uno se siente como en 'casa'. Cada uno de nosotros exponía una fotografía y leía un breve texto. A partir de ahí, de forma espontánea, entre todos iban surgiendo nuevas lecturas y matices como fruto de la acción conjunta de compartir nuestras miradas. Como dice nuestro compañero Javier López Rivera en la introducción a este libro, «la fotografía no ha llegado a nuestras vidas para sustituir a la palabra, sino para proponer sus propias narraciones gráficas que, en muchas ocasiones, se apoyarán en breves textos».

Desde el primer encuentro tuvimos claro que esta iniciativa no podía quedar tan solo en un recuerdo. Fue entonces cuando se fraguó el proyecto que culmina ahora con la publicación de este libro. 



Much has been written (and rewritten) about classic horror and science fiction films like *Nosferatu* and *Metropolis*, as well as not-so-classic pictures like *Bride of the Monster* and *The Hideous Sun Demon*. Yet some genre films have fallen through the cracks. The 24 films--some elusive, some easily found on YouTube--examined in this book all suffered critical neglect and were prematurely stacked in the attic. The authors bring them back into the light, beginning with *Der Tunnel* (1915), about the building of a transatlantic tunnel, and ending with *The Emperor's Baker--The Baker's Emperor* (1951), a bizarre Marxist take on the Golem legend. A variety of thrillers are covered--*Fog* (1933), *Return of the Terror* (1934), *Forgotten Faces* (1928)--along with such sci-fi leaps into the future as *The Sky Ranger* (1921), *High Treason* (1929) and *Just Imagine* (1930). Early adaptations include *The Man Who Laughs* (1921), *The Monkey's Paw* (1923), *Hound of the Baskervilles* (1937) and *Sweeney Todd* (1928). Rare stills and background material are included in a discussion of Hispanic vintage horror. The career of exploitation auteur, Bud Pollard (*The Horror*, 1933) is examined.


Science fiction films celebrate and critique the impact of a burgeoning technology on the world's cultural, political, and social milieu.

The Machine Age, roughly delineated by the two decades between World Wars, was a watershed period during which modern society entered into an ambiguous embrace with technology that continues today. J. P. Telotte carefully blends film, technology, cultural, and genre studies to illuminate this nearly forgotten era in our cinematic history and to show, through analysis of classics like *The Invisible Ray*, *Metropolis*, and *Things to Come*, how technology played a major role as motif, "actor," and producer.

What he also discovers as he ranges among the American, British, Russian, French, and German science fiction cinema — as well as mainstream films, figures, and cultural products such as the New York World's Fair — is a fundamental ambivalence, embedded in the films themselves, about the very machine-age ethos they promoted. Even as advances in the technical apparatus of filmmaking elevated it from mere entertainment to a medium of general communication and genuine artistic expression, Machine Age science fiction films remained curiously distant from and often skeptical of the very machines on which their narratives focus.

The resulting tensions, Telotte writes, "thus seem to intersect with those implicit in a Western world that was struggling with its own transition into the modern," rendering the films' task inevitably paradoxical and difficult

Reseña

Science fiction film examines one of the most enduring and popular genres of Hollywood cinema, suggesting how the science fiction film reflects attitudes toward science, technology, and reason as they have evolved in American culture over the course of the twentieth century. J. P. Telotte provides a survey of science fiction film criticism, emphasizing humanist, psychological, ideological, feminist, and postmodern critiques.

He also sketches a history of the genre, from its earliest literary manifestations to the present, while touching on and comparing it to pulp fiction, early television science fiction, and Japanese anime. Telotte offers in-depth readings of three key films: *Robocop*, *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*, and *THX 1138*, each of which typifies a particular form of science fiction fantasy. Challenging the boundaries usually seen between high and low culture, literature and film, *Science fiction film* reasserts the central role of fantasy in popular films, even those concerned with reason, science, and technology.
